Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Department's letter No. 15012/1/2022-MIDH dated 02.05.2022 about the administrative approval for implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme on Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH/HMNEH) under Krishonnati Yojna and to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of an amount of **Rs.22,68,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty-two crore and Sixty-eight Lakh only)** to Government of **Jammu & Kashmir** during 2022-23, for implementation of the Scheme in **Jammu & Kashmir**.

2. This assistance under the regular activities of the scheme is in the ratio of 90:10 by Central Government and State Government respectively.

3. In accordance with the revised procedure, the Reserve Bank of India may please be advised for debiting to the Account of the Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare and passing on the credit to the Central Account Section, Nagpur, for transfer to the State Government of **Jammu & Kashmir**.

4. The said Grants-in-aid will be subject to the following conditions: -

(a) The grants shall be utilized and disbursed by the concerned implementing agency in accordance with the MIDH Operational Guidelines, Revised Administrative Approval of Prime Minister's Development Package 2015 [Letter No. 33-63/2014-MIDH-Vol. (IV) (11770) –I dated 19<sup>th</sup> December 2019 and 33-63/2014-MIDH Vol.IV (FTS-107565) dated 20<sup>th</sup> June 2022]/Administrative Approval of MIDH for the year 2022-23 and in accordance with the conditions stipulated in this letter.

(b) The implementing agency shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure incurred and submit the statement of audited accounts and Utilization Certificates to this Department as soon as possible after the close of the financial year.
